## Irish Whiskey

First indication of an Irish Whiskey is the "E" in Whiskey. Scotch & most others are spelt Whisky!

Grains for Irish Whiskey are usually malted in ovens rather than open floor, much less smoke or peat flavors are infused, ask about the exceptions! Irish distillers generally choose to run their spirit through a still 3 times, whereas Scotland's distillers generally only run it twice.

## Single Malt Scotch Whisky

### REGIONS OF SCOTLAND

**Island of Islay** — A very specific flavor profile that is heavily peated, lots of iodine and big salty aftertastes. Two Islay distilleries still malt their own grain! Whiskies from the north side of Islay are mellower than those on the south

**Lowlands**—Where whisky production started in Scotland, once the most prolific producer now only offers 2 or 3.

**Highlands** — Speyside is the biggest area of Highland distilling. Known for flavor cask aging, such as using ex-filled Sherry or Port casks, with light smoke notes

**Islands (Non Islay)** — Distilleries located on the windswept islands around Scotland's coast including Skye, Orkney & Jura usually higher peat, smoke & salt notes
